

Pennsic Wars!



Years ago, HRM Cariadoc of the Bow, King of the Middle, got bored with peace and declared war upon the East Kingdom, loser to take Pittsburgh. The King of the East read the declaration of war, filed it away and forgot about it. Time passed. Cariadoc moved to New York and subsequently became King of the East, whereupon he retrieved the declaration from the file cabinet and said, "Let's fight." The Middle won thus, King Cariadoc has had the distinction of being the only king who declared war upon himself and lost.

This began the Pennsic Wars within the Society for Creative Anachronism. There have been 45 Pennsic Wars and the fight looks to be never ending as an annual event for us all. Pennsic 45 was the largest so far totaling 10,940 people from all over the world. Pennsic has grown to one of the largest events in the Known World. For two weeks every July-August a small region within the rolling hills of Pennsylvania becomes a city larger than most southern US cities.

If you have never been to Pennsic, you should make the pilgrimage at least once in your "Known World Life", it should almost be a requirement for membership. The first week of Pennsic is dedicated to classes, workshops, and tons of shopping for all participants. The 2nd week is called, War Week, and named rightly so! Fighting every day, all day! The night life at Pennsic can be never-ending and ongoing to some. Courts, parties, campfires, haflas, bards, and a chest of treasured memories for any and all to experience. Thousands of tents, pavilions, campers, motorhomes, and interesting constructions of all sorts can be seen when just wandering about.
