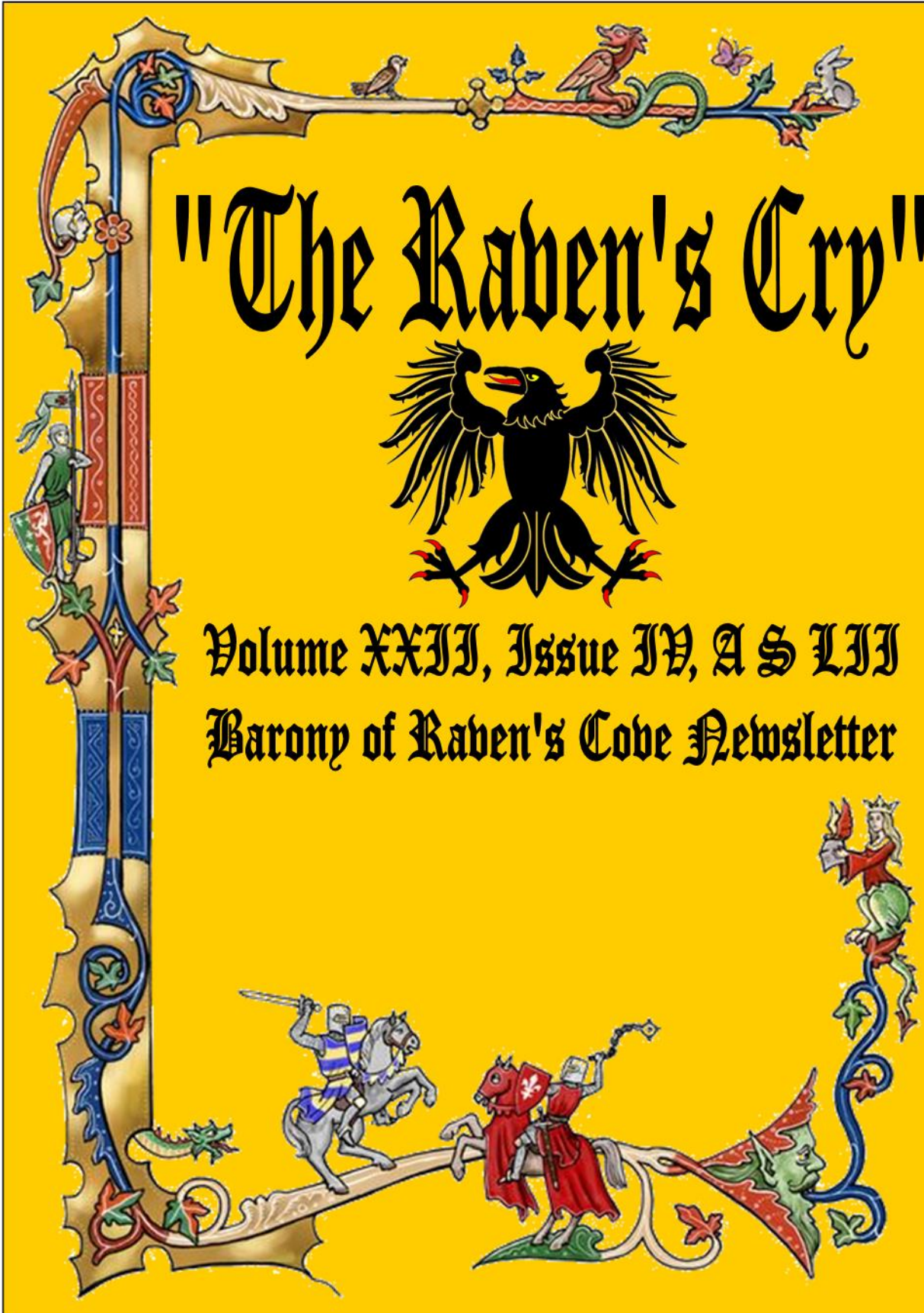

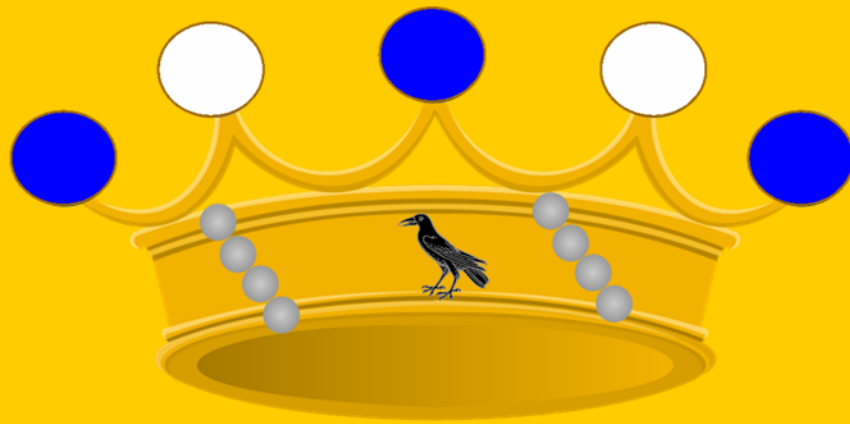

Ravens' Record

(being the minutes of the Baronial business meeting of the Barony of Raven's Cove, SCA Inc.)

Call to order

A meeting of The Barony of Raven's Cove, SCA Inc., was held at Old Chicago Pizza & Taproom, 4157 Western Blvd., #100, Jacksonville, NC 28546 on March 10, 2019 at 2:21 pm.

Approval of minutes

The minutes of the January 2019 baronial business meeting were published for comment in the February edition of the Raven's Cry. Having received no comments or corrections, let the record reflect that the prior minutes stand as approved.

Reports

Exchequer: Report given by Abrahm Polaski (Hlaford Vlfbeorn Ælfweardes sunu). The balance in the account is \$3,981.59. There are still a few outstanding checks, including the one to Mount Olive for Unevent, and the one to Cypress Creek for the additional day for Unbirthday. Otherwise, we are in good shape.

Minister of Arts & Sciences: Report given by Morag Polaski (Baroness Olwen de Montgomery). We have had two successful A&S nights at Michaels and are looking forward to more. If you are interested in teaching a class or having a class taught, please let the MoAS know.

Chatelaine: Report given by Lord Knutr Vakarsson (Jason Thomas). She continues to reach out to interested people, and we have flyers to put out in town to hopefully garner interest in the SCA.

Herald: Report given by Lord Lothian ap Lyonesse (Mark Lane). There are several things currently needing to be resubmitted, please speak with him about that. Baroness Edan recently posted a link to a gentleman who makes heraldic banners and flags on our Facebook page and Lord Lothian has ordered some from him and reports that they are a decent quality at a good price. Lord Lothian will be out of contact for about a week as of March 11, 2019. If you have pressing heraldic business, please contact Baron Lochlainn.

Chronicler: Report given by Lord Lothian ap Lyonesse (Mark Lane). Officers, please get your missives to him in a timely fashion, not the day after the deadline he posts.

Knight Marshal: Report given by Lord Knutr Vakarsson (Jason Thomas). Baroness Ingegerd is currently looking for a replacement as Knight Marshal. As it is not a necessary office for the group, it was suggested that the office be done away with for the moment (until a replacement can be found), as long as the reports are submitted in a timely manner.

Seneschal: Report given by Jason Thomas (Lord Knutr Vakarsson). There is lots of good stuff happening in and around the barony, and things seem to be going well.

Baronage: Report given by Jim and Heather Rardin (Baron Lochlainn and Baroness Edan). They are working on the resubmission of the Order of the Zephyr. If you have submitted a recommendation for a baronial award through the kingdom website, please send them a copy directly as they are not getting notified from the Kingdom that the recommendations are there. Baroness Edan has written an article in the current Raven's Cry about being a landed Baroness and urges the populace to read it.

Old business

Coastal Raids Unbirthday: The site opens at 5 pm on Friday and we will need folks on site at 3:30pm to help set up the baronial pavilion etc. We will need checks for the troll cash float, and for the feastocrat to buy food. Please remember that Her Royal Highness, Princess Adelheit, will be in attendance at our event (with her ferret). If you are on the staff and need people to help out, please get your crew together now. There will be no marshals from Raven's Cove, which will give all Ravens the opportunity to compete for Champion and to participate in the martial arts.

Nine Realms: The staff page is being developed. Please submit a photo and an email to Erin by Friday, March 15, 2019 if you haven't already done so. The dayboard looks like it will be about \$1500, and the cook has determined that they will not need to be paid for it upfront. The dayboard menu should be published by the end of the week. Lord Bumba and Baroness Edan will be making a site visit soon to do a layout map and once that is done it will be posted on Facebook and at troll. If you are on the staff and need people to help out, please get your crew together now. If you wish to volunteer in a particular capacity, please contact the person in charge of that area, not the autocrat.

Strawberry Festival: This conflicts with Spring Crown. Even though only Their Excellencies will be attending Crown, it was determined that participating in the November Twilight at Christmas demo in Wallace would be a better option. Lord Lothian will look into that.

Military Leadership: This symposium will be held April 12, 2019, with 4 workshops for the day. This is a closed event, not an SCA demo. The 4H kids will rotate through the workshops. Ashley needs people to teach areas, emphasizing the leadership skills, like courtesy, team building, etc. Please contact Ashley for more information.

4-H Camp: Ashley has been allowed to take an intensive week-long class for her CE requirements during the week (June 24-27) we had discussed for the camp this year. The Pamlico County 4H agent (Kate) was in attendance at the meeting.

Loaner Archery Equipment: It was discussed at an earlier meeting to purchase some arrows to replace some of the baronial loaner arrows. Lord Juan has researched the cost and availability and found a dozen 30-inch arrow for approximately \$40 on Amazon that will suit our needs. The populace voted to purchase these arrows, and Lord Juan was reminded to follow up with SeaReach to discuss their offer to replace some of the baronial arrows that were lost and/or damaged during Sheep Raids.

Motions

Motion to buy 1 dozen arrows from Amazon for the barony was made by Lord Juan and seconded by Hlaford Vlfbeorn. It passed by a show of hands with 1 nay.

New Business

War of the Wings: Raven's Cove and Hawkwood are the principals this year for WotW. Their Excellencies are working on getting A&S information and fighting information to the staff for WotW as soon as possible so it can get out to the populace as soon as possible. We will need a camp coordinator (Var) and a camp kitchen coordinator (Freydis). Our focus will be on the A&S and Bardic competitions as they are worth more points. We will need an A&S coordinator (Neshka). We also want to include the equestrians as a war point. Lord Knutr was contacted by a SCAdian who works in a print shop who is interested in making tshirts for sale, with a portion of the proceeds going to the baronies. Mistress Katharine has offered a prize for the winning tshirt design.

Kingdom Regalia: Recently, Their Majesties posted that there is a need to repair/replace some regalia items. Lady Alexandria would like to make cloaks for the Kingdom as a gift from the barony, to be presented to TRM at the investiture of the new baron and baroness. If you have design ideas, please speak with Lady Alexandria, and we will vote on this at the next meeting.

Next Meeting: Will be held on April 28, 2019 at 2 pm. The place will be determined and announced on the group Facebook page.

Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the populace, the meeting was adjourned at 3:17 pm.
