Populace Meeting Minutes August 26, 2012

Minister of Youth: Still awaiting warrant.

Minister of Arts & Science: Sheet walls for WOW are being worked on. Banners will be focus of next A&S Session. Mordrea gave specifics of measurements of banners and relayed information about supplies as far as where to obtain them and possible pricing; all information to be posted on the website for use. Also, Scriptorium is available for those interested. Populace was asked to make medallions to be handed out at our courts to be held in the future. The Kingdom OP has been updated. Scrolls from Unbirthday were distributed to their recipients.

Baronage: Baron Torquil stated that cooler weather is on the way and the Fall Season is upon us. If there are any award recommendations, please let him or Baroness Katharine know. They will, in turn, send word to their Majesties if any awards are to be given during court. WOW is on its way and armor workshop will be opening soon, due to new location where it is to be held. Fighters were encouraged to check their armor and ensure it is ready for fighting. Baroness Katharine stated that at the time, no decision has been made on whom we will be allies with for WOW. The Populace was encouraged to register for the encampment for WOW and the populace was advised that Sea Reach would be sharing our area and kitchen. If financial help is needed for fees for WOW, let the Baronage know and something may be worked out.
