The Regional Seneschal Lord Jehan Franc announced to the populace present of the temporary Kingdom Seneschal replacement Sir Bryce de Bryan. Anyone interested in the position of Kingdom Seneschal should contact Sir Bryce and their Highnesses by March 15th.

Officer Reports

Seneschal - Lady Edan, requested that all officers check their report due dates and to make sure she receives a copy of their report.

Minister of the List-Lord Jehan Franc ask anyone needing to renew or transfer their cards to see him. All fighters need to check their fighting cards to make sure they are current.

Chirurgeon-Lord Lochlainn reported that there had not been any injuries at any event or fighter practices.

Exchequer-m'lady Amira is now the warranted Exchequer for the Barony as of February. She reported the balance in the coffers and said the coronets have been paid for along with the postage for the polling letters.

Minister of Minors- Lady Edan ask anyone interested in filling this office to contact her after the meeting. The Barony needs to have this office filled for our children.

Chronicler-Lady Dar informed the group that she is awaiting her warrant. The next issue of the Cry will be out next week. Let her know if there is anything you would like to see, or put into the Cry.

Herald-Lord Lochlainn informed the group that 45% of our members have registered names and devices. This is very good but he would like to see our percentage higher. We currently have three devices awaiting final approval and 6 needing name or art changes. There will be special A&S meeting on Heraldry at Baron Torquil's home on March 27 at 6:30 p.m. The Triton Herald and other important guests will be present for heraldic consultation. The title of Nevermore for the Baronial Herald will not pass due to being too modern. It was moved, seconded and passed unanimously to table the discussion to the next meeting so more suggestions from the populace. The Order of the Crossed Dirks will not pass as written and it was moved, seconded and unanimously passed to change it to the Order of the Crossed Durks. The Award of the Drakkar Prow will also not pass as written and it was moved, seconded and unanimously passed to change it to the Award of the Prow. The two pieces of artwork for the Order of the Black Gull were presented by Lord Eoghan and it was moved, seconded and unanimously passed to accept the gull on the branch for submission

Chatelaine-Report has been submitted on February 10th. Have more brochures.

Web Minister – Lady Dar informed the group that changes are still being worked on the site. If you have any pictures of our populace please send them to her for posting on the web page. If you do not see your name listed or any other corrections or item that need to be added please let her know.

Quarter Master – Lady Dar reported that the new coronets have been added to the Baronial property list.

Minister of Arts & Science – Mistress Mordeyrn requested class ideas, suggestions or needs from the populace for future classes. The following classes are scheduled: March 13 – Etiquette, March 27 – Heraldry, April 3 – Pennants, Baronial decorations and Kumihimo. Other requested class was bookmaking. Mistress Mordeyrn informed the group of the passing of Mistress Jaela. For those interested in a separate scribal A&S to please contact her so a date can be set.

Knight Marshall-Baron Torquil requested a meeting of all fighters after the meeting to inform them of

new things coming down from Kingdom on fighting.

Baronage-Baron Torquil informed the group of the new baronage of Notting Hill Coil. Tourney and travel season is starting so please let either him or Baroness Katharine if you are planning to attend any events so if someone needs something transported of A&S or carpooling they can help. Also if you have any award recommendations please make sure that you let them know when you submit them. The Crown often speaks to them concerning the recommendation and it is good if they are informed of the recommendation beforehand.

baroness katharine's project

for the past few years, the kingdom of atlantia has seen many of its players cut down by the insidious disease of cancer. Many others have been touched by this either personally or through friends and relatives. I have personally lost several aunts, uncles, close friends and fellow scadians to some form of cancer. It has touched me deeply as I know it has touched many of you.

while we cannot single handedly cure those we know of this disease, we can help to make someone's life a little better as well as letting them know that they are in our hearts and in our prayers, that is what has started my project - the thought that those undergoing chemotherapy or radiation therapy will not be left alone, a simple thing like a chemo-cap or prayer shawl can make a world of difference in a cancer patient's life.

and so, I ask for your help. If you know how to knit or crochet or even make a blanket out of fleece, I ask that you donate a chemo-cap or prayer shawl to my project. I have included several links to websites that provide directions for your use. There are very few rules to follow and they are pretty simple:

1) softer yarns: cotton, baby yarn, soft worsted like 'caron simply soft' or 'lion brand' pound of Love' are more comfortable to wear, and cotton is really nice for summer.

2) thinner, seamless (crochet or knit in the round), non-lumpy caps for sleeping/increased comfort on the recipients heads.

3) please use yarns without wool content.

- 4) If there are animals in your house, please include a card with that information as some people are allergic.
- 5) please wash and machine dry hats before sending, as this will often soften them.

6) do not use scented fabric softeners as many people are allergic to them.

7) please include a card with your name (mundane) and address so that I can send you a small "thank you".

thank you for participating in my project. If you wish to bring your completed projects to upcoming events, I will be attending ymir, nottinghill coill baronial investiture, and of course, spring crown tournament. Just look for the raven's cove heraldry and stop by. I will be most appreciative.
