**Exchequer:** m'lady Amira, our new Exchequer, informed the group that the 4th quarter and Doomsday reports are done and balance. The final payment for the new Baronial Coronets has been made and we now await their arrival. Balance of coffers was given. We have no outstanding checks or purchases.

**Minister of Youth:** We are currently in need of someone for this office. Lady Emmie has graciously stepped up to do our children's activities at the Spring Crown Tourney. Please speak to the Seneschal if you have an interest.

**Chronicler:** Lady Dar will be stepping up as our Chronicler. She reminded everyone that when new people join either our web group or Facebook please welcome them on line and see if they need any information and get it to them. Also call the Chatelaine and give her their information so she is aware of the new contact. The suggestion was made to check on making some form of welcome packet to be mailed or sent to new people. It will be worked on and an example brought to the next meeting for discussion and review.

**Web Minister:** Lady Dar, the deputy web minister, reported that there have been changes on web page. Please check out our web page and let her know if there is anything that needs to be changed or added. Everyone is also reminded to send pictures to put in our historical archives. Photo release forms will be made available at all gates in the future so we can use the photos. **Minister of Arts & Science:** Report was given by Seneschal, Lady Edan. Still need more scrolls for both the Barony and the Kingdom backlog. Contact her if you would like individual help or bring to A&S and she will assist you. Several members are working on garb. Please take pictures of your projects in progress, as well as finished, so she can put them on the web.

**Herald:** the new Baronial Herald is now Lord Lochlainn, Vincento sent all the Herald papers and staff for turn over to him. It was reported for the Herald that he currently has 3 resubmissions and is working on getting visuals of all devices & items registered. We should hear about the conformation of the title on Nevermore soon. Please go through you Baronial Herald with all submissions or inform him if you have sent in any submissions by other means.

**Chatelaine:** We have several new members and information is being given out at fighter practices and A&S. At fighter practice last Sunday all the current supply of brochures and business cards were given out. A new supply of brochures is now available from the Chatelaine if you need some.

**Knight Marshall:** Baron Torquil reported that last Sunday's fighter practice was very popular at the park, many people were taking photos and asking about the SCA. There is open armor workshop on Wednesdays at his home. Please call him if you have any questions. Ymir is coming up. This is start of the tourney season so if possible please attend. If you want to learn things this is a good place to begin. There will be fighter practice this Sunday at the park.

**Baronage:** Baroness Katharine and Baron Torquil discussed the upcoming events. They would like to see recommendations for awards sent to Kingdom and also some for Baronial level. Please copy them on any Kingdom award recommendations. Baroness Katharine would like to see everyone's personal banners hanging in the Baronial Pavilion.

#### Old Business:

**Spring Crown Tourney:** ACEPS is already up for registration. The staffing was discussed and areas still needing staff. Senor Juan Baptist volunteered the ship Blackbird will cover the parking, garbage and security at the event. The site is wet. There is no garbage pickup so if you bring it in you take it out. Photo releases will be available at the gate when people come in. Baroness Maderun will do the programs and needed signage. Everyone pays and works the event. ## baroness katharine's project

for the past few years, the kingdom of atlantia has seen many of its players cut down by the insidious disease of cancer. many others have been touched by this either personally or through friends and relatives. I have personally lost several aunts, uncles, close friends and fellow scadians to some form of cancer. It has touched me deeply as I know it has touched many of you.

while we cannot single handedly cure those we know of this disease, we can help to make someone's life a little better as well as letting them know that they are in our hearts and in our prayers, that is what has started my project - the thought that those undergoing chemotherapy or radiation therapy will not be left alone, a simple thing like a chemo-cap or prayer shawl can make a world of difference in a cancer patient's life.

and so, I ask for your help. If you know how to knit or crochet or even make a blanket out of fleece, I ask that you donate a chemo-cap or prayer shawl to my project. I have included several links to websites that provide directions for your use. there are very few rules to follow and they are pretty simple:

1) softer yarns: cotton, baby yarn, soft worsted like 'caron simply soft' or 'lion brand' pound of Love' are more comfortable to wear, and cotton is really nice for summer.

2) thinner, seamless (crochet or knit in the round), non-lumpy caps for sleeping/increased comfort on the recipients heads.

3) please use yarns without wool content.

4) if there are animals in your house, please include a card with that information as some people are allergic.

5) please wash and machine dry hats before sending, as this will often soften them.

6) So not use scented fabric softeners as many people are allergic to them.

7) please include a card with your name (mundane) and address so that I can send you a small "thank you".

thank you for participating in my project. If you wish to bring your completed projects to upcoming events, I will be attending ymir, nottinghill coill baronial investiture, and of course, spring crown tournament. Just look for the raven's cove heraldry and stop by. I will be most appreciative.
