






Greetings to our fair barony!!

Currently finishing up drawings of three members' devices and checking names. The Barony is getting ready to make Sheet Walls so everyone has Heraldry represented for WoW.



Announcements:

Officers' Reports:

Chiurgeon – Heat issues continue to be on the rise. The Society has not yet decided on the issue concerning the office of the Chiurgeon in Atlantia.

Exchequer- Baronial coffers remain the same.

Chronicler- Our new Chronicler is working on acquiring her warrant with aid from the lovely and wonderful Kingdom Chronicler.

Arts and Sciences- We are working on creating new and diverse classes. Currently, we are creating a series of classes based around the SCA and the different roles one can have within the society. The new class calendar will be out soon. Announcement: Kingdom is looking for a new A&S deputy.

Herald – Several submissions of names and devices from the Barony are still pending.

Knight Marshall- We had an awesome practice the first week of July with coaching from Duke Bryan. Many of our fighters were able to practice some new techniques and receive feedback! We are looking to change the layout of fighter practices to being thirty minutes of war tactics and spear drills, followed by regular practice. Several fighters are looking to authorize at the upcoming Peasants Revolt in the Shire of Cathanar. The Barony will also be pursuing a Rapier side of the house.





Old Business:

We are still looking into the purchase of a new trailer. There are two possible trailers, but waiting on the price to drop.

New Business:

Baronial Birthday – Birthday will once again be held at Cypress Creek. It will be Viking themed, with various melee scenarios and a recreation of the Battle of Stamford Bridge. The feast will be documentable Viking fare. Site fee \$8.00 (Member) and feast will be \$6.


Peasants Revolt – We are using the Baronial Pavilion. Please come!

We are looking into making spacer sheet walls with Raven's Cove heraldry to fill in the rest of the wall and represent members without official heraldry. Improvements are being made to the WoW site. The cutoff date for registering for WoW (if you want to camp with us) is September 6 (please let Lochlainn know).

Baron and Baroness – In just over a year the process will begin to appoint a new Baron and Baroness. If you are interested in becoming Baron or Baroness, please talk to their Excellences.

The date for the next Populace meeting is August 24, after Peasant's Revolt.






Upcoming Events of Baronial Interest
