

Ravens,



Greetings unto the Grand Conspiracy of Ravens!!



RAVENS' RECORD

(being the minutes of the Baronial business meeting of the Barony of Raven's Cove, SCA Inc.)

19 August 2017

Hlaford Vlfbeorn called the meeting to order at 4:45 pm, and there were 10 people in attendance.

OFFICERS REPORTS:

Baron/Baroness: (Baron Lochlainn hua Rigbarddain/Baroness Edan Lowery) Their Excellencies wanted to note that event season is upon us and to remind us to bring goodies to share on the hospitality tables we set up at events. Additional Her Excellency is head retainer for Prince Amos and Princess Kara.

Seneschal: (Hlaford Vlfbeorn Ælfweardes sunu) Halford Vlfbeorn stated that the current website looked good, but there were some changes that needed to be made. He also stated that while we have most baronial offices filled (the Chancellor of Youth still being vacant), almost all the baronial offices need deputies. He urged members of the populace to consider volunteering to be a deputy officer.

Chancellor of the Exchequer: (Señor Juan de Rojo) Señor Juan was not present, however Hlaford Vlfbeord had received the exchequer's report and relayed that all the outstanding bills for the Arthurian Deed had been paid; and that corrections were needed on some previous year end reports, and that Señor Juan was working on the reports for the first two quarters of the year as there were some correction necessary on those.

Chatelaine: (Lady Cara of Raven's Cove) Lady Cara was not present and Mistress Katherine gave the report. The Kingdom Chatelaine and the Southern Regional Deputy Chatelaine are both stepping down and replacements need to be found for them. Requirements for the office may be found in the Acorn.

Chronicler: (Lord Lothian ap Lyonesse) Lord Lothian was not in attendance, and Baroness Olwen gave report. Lord Lothian is in need of missives, stories, and other submissions for the Cry. Also, please remember that the website and the Raven's Cry are the official publications of the Barony, things posted on Facebook are not official, but merely convenient.

Herald: (Lady Rhiannon of Raven's Cove) Most submissions are passing and people should be getting notifications from Kingdom about their submissions.

Knight Marshall: (Lord David of Raven's Cove) Lord David was not present and the report was given by Baron Lochlainn. Currently, we are attempting to have two practices a week, the Sunday practice is generally organized by Lord David, while the Thursday practice is organized by Baron Lochlainn.

Minister of Arts & Sciences: (Ian the Ranger) Ian was not present and the report was given by Baroness Olwen. A&S nights/classes are going well, with the next being Autocrat 101 today. Looking for teachers and subjects to cover, please volunteer. Their Excellencies noted that the next three months will be crazy busy for them, so A&S classes may have to move location temporarily.

Minister of the Lists: (Baroness Olwen de Montgomery) Baroness Olwen will be the MOL in charge at our upcoming Baronial Birthday and announced that there will be a MOL 101 class at Birthday for those interested in becoming a MOL.

OLD BUSINESS:

Baronial Birthday – this is the final planning meeting. There will be a dayboard/hospitality table, so please bring donations. Lord Lothian will be the hall steward; Hlaford Vlfbeord will be the field coordinator

Queen's Rapier – October 14. We are still staffing some positions, Mistress Katherine volunteered to be head troll, otherwise all is going well.

War of the Wings – October 18-22. We will be hosting a hafla on Saturday and signup for chores will be forthcoming. Their Majesties of Aethelmearc will be joining us, but in a small camp of their own.

Demonstrations – Demos at the Strawberry Festival and national Night Out were tabled to another meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Winter University – a bid has been submitted with lady Alexandria autocratting it. The bid was received, but no decision has yet been made.

Rip Rap War – September 8-10 in Marinus. Their Excellencies received a letter of marque from Their Excellencies of Marinus to sponsor a boat. Boats need to be assembled on site. There is a very strong likelihood that Their Excellencies of Raven's Cove will be hosting Their Royal Highnesses at Rip Rap War.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Newcomers were welcomed to the group.

There being no further business, the populace meeting adjourned at 5:57 pm.


