

(being the minutes of the Baronial business meeting of the Barony of Raven's Cove, SCA Inc.)

Call to order

A meeting of The Barony of Raven's Cove, SCA Inc., was held at 309 Rock Creek Drive, Richlands, NC 28574 on March 4, 2018 at 3:08 pm.

Approval of minutes

The minutes of the February 2018 baronial business meeting were published for comment in the March edition of the Raven's Cry. Having received no comments or corrections, let the record reflect that the prior minutes stand as approved.

Reports

Excheguer: Report given by Abrahm Polaski (Hlaford Vlfbeorn Ælfweardes sunu). We are doing well, we have \$4,102.07 including what needs to go out to the University. Wants to encourage everyone to autocrat as a learning experience. If you want to spend money, please plan in advance, and budget it. Unexpected expenses do happen and we can vote on reimbursement or write a taxable donation receipt after the fact. Barony issued a check last year for \$292 for University. It is still uncashed. We need to cut a new check and send it to University but need to discuss whether to put a stop payment on the old check. Minister of Arts & Sciences: Report given by Morag Polaski (Baroness Olwen de Montgomery). The leather get-together will be happening on March 17 at Baroness Ingegerd and Lord Knutr's house. This will kick off our monthly A&S meetings. Movie night/fighter practice on April 21 at Their Excellencies' house. Scriptorium meetings are being organized by Angela Sharpe (Mistress Morderyn) at her home or at Port City Java/Starbucks if there are more people than her home can hold. The first scriptorium meeting is tentatively set for March 21, she will post details in the Cry and on the Baronial Facebook page. John Romero (Lord Juan) is offering an atlatl class on May 19, 2018. More details will be posted in the Cry and the Baronial Facebook page. Angela Sharpe (Mistress Morderyn) will be offering a class in banner making prior to WotW. Kati Kam-

Chatelaine: Report given by Laura Garcia (Mistress Katherine de la Vache). Angela Sanderson (Lady Arria) will be taking over the office in April. The office if looking for serviceable garb, so please donate if you have any. We have loaner armor as well.

eroski (Baroness Ingegerd) will be holding a glass bead making class on June 2

Herald: Report given by Mark Lane Sr. (Lord Lothian ap Lyonesse). Kingdom letters and letters from Laurel are both out, please check your email for status if you have anything in the system. If anything needs to be resubmitted, please contact Mark (Lord Lothian).

Chronicler: Report given by Mark Lane Sr. (Lord Lothian ap Lyonesse). Please give Mark (Lord Lothian) any submissions – songs, stories, articles, etc. Each officer will have their own page, so please fill it. The barony is growing and Lauren Smith Mayberry (Lady Rhiannon) has been appointed to be the Baronial Historian, under the Chronicler.

Knight Marshal: Report given by Kati Kameroski (Baroness Ingegerd Kastanrazi). We are wanting to get regular weekly practices set up, as well as a quarterly regional fighter practice. Scenarios for Coastal Raids are in the works and we should have enough marshals to make sure that no one is stuck solely marshalling. Friday nights for a weekly practice seem to work for the barony. We have parks in Onslow County that we can use, as well as Their Excellencies' home. There is also a possible indoor site. First weekly fighter practice is set for March 16 at 6 pm at Jason and Kati's (Lord Knutr and Baroness Ingegerd) home.

Seneschal: Report given by Jason Thomas (Lord Knutr Vakarsson). Polling of confidence is coming up soon. We are waiting on mailing labels from Milpitas. These will be followed up on by the Seneschal. Polling is due Their Royal Highnesses postmarked by March 24, 2018. Recruiting is very important and a focus point right now.

Baronage: Report given by Jim and Heather Rardin (Baron Lochlainn and Baroness Edan). Mistress Caitlin has a Raven's Cove banner for sale for \$50. This is a used banner, used formerly at War of the Wings.

Unfinished business

Fall University: This event would fall one week prior to our Baronial birthday. This is not feasible for our time and resources. We will not be putting in a bid for this event.

Coastal Raids (April 14-15, 2018): Abrahm Polaski (Hlaford Vlfbeorn) stated that the changeover from Seneschal to Exchequer has put him behind on planning for this event. We have a budget set, and with the cost of the site and the cost of the feast, we only need 18 people to attend in order to break even. Kati (Baroness Ingegerd) will be the marshal, Abrahm (Hlaford Vlfbeorn) is sponsoring the Holmgang and will be providing prizes for all the tourneys. Most of the sponsored competitions will have prizes provided by the sponsor. We only have the site on Saturday and Sunday. We need to be there early on Saturday to set up. All staff positions are filled. The feast is set and planned for, with appetizers, 2 courses and a dessert course. Troll opens at 8 on Saturday, with Mistress Katherine as head troll.

Parrot Sanctuary (March 24, 2018): Jason (Lord Knutr) will be getting up with the POC for this demo.

Strawberry Festival (May 11-12, 2018): Mark Lane Sr. (Lord Lothian) is heading up this demo at the Strawberry Festival this year. Our display of pigment making will not be there as Sajah is unable to come. Angela Sanderson (Lady Arria) will be doing a scribal display. We will have middle eastern dancers present as well. Bring your easy portable A&S stuff (spinning, embroidery, lampworking). There will be pamphlets there for the public. There may be roaming bards and Commedia. Favors for fighters will be given out, possibly gold and black ribbon, or candy.

National Night Out (August 7, 2018): John Romero (Lord Juan de Rojo) is heading up this demo. Will we be taking the day shade or a pop up, do we need computers/electricity? We will be discussing this closer to the date.

Baronial Birthday (September 2018): Laura Garcia (Mistress Katherine) has put together a bid for this event to be held on September 22, with a Crusader theme. She has a feastocrat

(Jason Thomas (Lord Knutr)), there will be a \$10 site fee and \$8 feast fee for this event. There will be several A&S competitions, as well as a novice prize for fighting offered by Seareach. Their Excellencies will not be asking for letters of intent to compete for the champion positions.

Motions

A motion was made by Mark Lane Sr. (Lord Lothian) and seconded by Morag Polaski (Baroness Olwen) for a stop payment for a fee of \$31 to be put on the outstanding University check. The motion was carried by a show of hands of a majority of the populace.

A motion was made to purchase the Baronial banner from Mistress Caitlin for \$50. The motion was made by Mark Lane (Lord Lothian) and seconded by Laura Garcia (Mistress Katherine). The motion was carried by a vote of 13 paid members of the barony.

A motion was made to no longer put a bid in for the 100th session of the University due to time constraints and the timing of our baronial birthday event. The motion was made by Abrahm Polaski (Hlaford Vlfbeorn) and seconded by Mark Lane Sr. (Lord Lothian) and carried by a show of hands of a majority of the populace.

A motion was made to accept Laura Garcia's (Mistress Katherine) bid for baronial birthday. It was moved by Mark Lane (Lord Lothian), seconded by Abrahm Polaski (Hlaford Vlfbeorn) and carried by a show of hands of the majority of the populace.

New Business

4-H Camp: Ashley Brooks is the 4-H Extension Agent for Craven County with a proposal for an 8-week medieval camp, one day per week, for kids 8-15. At the end of the 8 weeks, there would be a demo including fighting. The day would be in the middle of the week, based around the needs of the majority of the group and the existing schedule. This may be a possible tie in with potential event sites.


A challenge: Sir Eckhard challenged Lord Juan to a fight at some date as yet to be determined.
