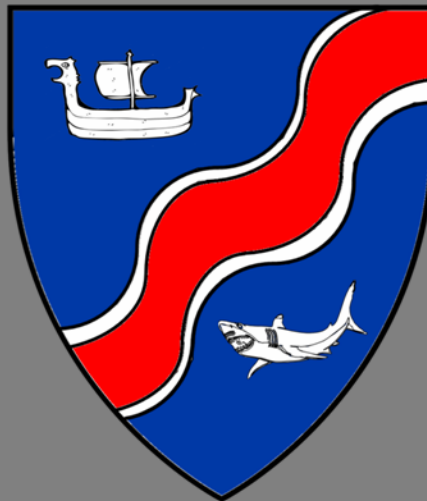
From the Seneshal
