Call to order

A meeting of The Barony of Raven's Cove, SCA Inc., was held at Jacksonville Commons Park, 100 Recreation Lane, Jacksonville, NC 28546 on April 28, 2019 at 3:10 pm.

Approval of minutes

The minutes of the March 2019 baronial business meeting were published for comment in the March edition of the Raven's Cry. Having received no comments or corrections, let the record reflect that the prior minutes stand as approved.

Reports

Exchequer: Report given by Abrahm Polaski (Hlaford Vlfbeorn Ælfweardes sunu). The balance in the account is \$3,981.59. There are still a few outstanding checks, including the one to Mount Olive for Unevent, and the one to Cypress Creek for the additional day for Un-birthday. Otherwise, we are in good shape.

Minister of Arts & Sciences: Report given by Morag Polaski (Baroness Olwen de Montgomery). We will be having an A&S night on May 9 at Michael's. The topic will be Retaining 101, taught by Her Excellency Baroness Edan. Our A&S meeting in June will be an open project night, and Mistress Morderyn has volunteered to teach a banner making class which will be held in July. We are currently without a Knight Marshal, however, after discussion with the other marshals in the group, it has been decided that our loaner equipment will remain loaner equipment and only be taken to fighter practices in an effort to encourage all interested fighters to get their own gear.

Baronage: Report given by Jim and Heather Rardin (Baron Lochlainn and Baroness Edan). Their request to have our baronial birthday moved to March has been approved. They will be extending their term for 6 months in order to give everyone the necessary time to get the polling started.
