Approval of minutes

The minutes of the December 2024 baronial business meeting were published for comment in the January 2025 edition of the Raven's Cry. Having received no comments or corrections, let the record reflect that the prior minutes stand as approved.

Reports

Seneschal: Report given by Ian Bell (Lord Ivan Mezey). Everything has been rather quiet right now, everyone is getting things done and signed. Quiet is good.

Exchequer: Report given by Jim Rardin (Master Lochlainn). Even made \$523.04 assuming there's no requests for refunds, other than the \$40 double charge by SCORES. We took in \$1,550 at gate and \$890 via SCORES, \$21.14 SCORES fee, \$4,767.64 in bank account

Chronicler: Report given by Jim Rardin (Master Loch). Please turn in missives this week so it can be published by the 1st.

Minister of Arts & Sciences: Report given by Amy Ipock (Mistress Finnech). A&S reports went in on time, and all is good. A&S at Birthday went well and everyone was impressed. Mistress Brig will be teach silk painting at the end of the month via Zoom. If anyone wants to put together an article on the dresses and documentation done for Birthday, please see Mistress Finnech. Ursus Bay is having a sewing day on Feb 16, please support them.

Chatelaine: Report given by Kait Neeland (m'lady Schiphrah). Reports went in on time.

Herald: Report given by John Ipock (Lord Tiberius). Lot of people got cool stuff at Baronial Birthday.

Marshal: Report given by Felicia Padgett (Baroness Freydis). Working with Mistress Finnech. The 14th and 15th of February will be the next Arts and Armor if we have another marshal. If not, we will support the A&S. Lord Ivan will marshal rapier, Lord Tiberius will marshal heavy. Her Excellency will work with Katie and Mistress Finnech to get it all organized. Concussion protocol training is coming as a requirement for marshals, Master Loch will ensure getting the link out to people interested.

Webminister: Report given by Jim Rardin (Master Loch). He would all officers please look at the regnum bios and send him a bio to finish off that part of the site.

Social Media Officer: Report given by Kaelinn Padgett (Lady Rota). We have a Bluesky account, which is essentially a Twitter alternative. We may or may not use it, but we have it if we want to and to keep cybersquatters off of it. No information has migrated over to it. She will post links to it and Loch will post it to the website.

Baronage: Report given by Felicia Padgett (Baroness Freydis). They have had a hard time putting thoughts about Birthday into words for Facebook but will get a missive out to the Cry. They are focused on Ymir as their next event. Heather de Kent has agreed to help with dayboard at events that will have a lot of Ravens at. The theme for Ymir's dayboard will be chili and people can sign up for what they'd like to bring to go with the chili. Field space for Ymir has been requested. Baronial progress is posted on website and will be updated as often as possible. They cannot be more proud of how the Ravens took on Birthday and cannot thank the populace enough.

Unfinished business

East Coast Ren Faire: Schiphrah is getting radio silence from the organizers. There are Facebook posts, but no one is responding to Schiphrah's calls/emails. Freydis will forward all the contact information from the previous year and Schiphrah will keep us posted.

Zoom/Wordpress Accounts: We are not eligible for not for profit for WordPress but get a tax exemption for Zoom. We can pay by check, but it will take a bit longer to get everything set up.

Proposed Baronial Policy Changes: Proposed changes will be published in the February Cry.

Knight's Marshall and Webminister offices: There were two people who submitted to hold these offices – Baroness Freydis and Master Loch, who are both currently holding the offices.

A motion was made by Heather Rardin (Mistress Edan) and seconded by Jim Rardin (Lochlainn) to elect Baroness Freydis to the position of the Knight's Marshall. Passed.

A motion was made by John Ipock (Lord Tiberius) and seconded by Duane Messner to elect Master Loch to the position of Webminister. Passed.

A motion was made by Morag Black (Baroness Olwen) and seconded by Duane Messner to put together a bid for Spring Coronation 2027. Passed.

New Business

Chronicler's office position: Interested candidates should send an email to the seneschal. It will be announced on social media and in the Cry. Application cut off is the next meeting.

Queen's Rapier Tourney: Baroness Freydis would like us to host this event on April 19 at the Halifax 4-H complex. The theme is based on 13th century Spain. Baroness Freydis will put together the appropriate bid paperwork and we can take a vote on it via social media instead of at a meeting. There is a deadline of January 30 for the budget to be submitted to the populace.

Spring Coronation 2027: Mistress Edan would like to discuss our hosting this event as a joust at Halifax 4H.

Baronial Day Shade: Baron Ragnulfr would like to explore replacing the current day shade cutting down the Baronial day shade to make it easier to travel with. Tabled for next meeting.

Next Meeting: February 20, 2025 at 7 p.m. via Zoom.

A motion was made by John Ipock (Lord Tiberius) and seconded by Duane Messner to adjourn the meeting. Passed.

There being no further business to come before the populace, the meeting was adjourned at 7:52 p.m.
